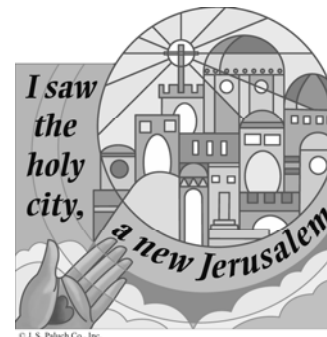
— Weekly Reflection —

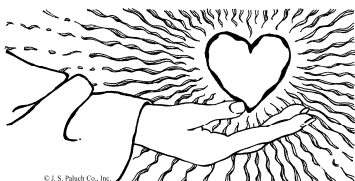
