## Pillars of St. Peter's Church

We are working on the Donor Walls that will be installed in the entrance of the church, hopefully within the next few months. There will be two walls. The Memorial Wall will be on the South side and will include the names of those who have pledged for items of the Church in memory of a loved one, such as the windows, crucifix, Stations of the Cross, pictures, etc. The Memorial Wall has already been verified. If you have pledged for a Memorial and have not been contacted, please call Phyllis at the church Office: 924-2562.

The Wall on the North side will be called the "Pillars of St. Peter's Church" and will list the names, in alphabetical order, of all the Parish families who have contributed to the New Church Building Fund since 1994, the beginning of the Campaigns. Only the names of those who have been recorded as contributing will appear on the Board. These names will be etched on glass panels that will be attached to the wall, so we want to be sure the names are spelled and listed correctly because we cannot make corrections or changes after the Walls are installed.

At the back of the church are temporary boards listing all the names of those who have contributed to the Building Fund from 1994 through today. Please check out the boards to see if your name is listed and spelled correctly. Only the names of the husband and wife will be used. We cannot list every child in the family. If it is correct, great, you do not need to do anything. Your name will appear on the Board as is.

If you cannot find your name and feel that you have contributed to the Building Fund or if your name is misspelled or listed incorrectly, please fill out the form available near the board letting me know the problem. Please do not write on the Board itself. Be sure to fill in the form by printing legibly. It is very important that I have your phone number so I can contact you if needed. You may either leave the completed form on the table there or drop it by the Church Office. All issues will be researched and if necessary you will be called to discuss the problem. We are making every effort to correct any errors or make changes before the list is finalized for etching, but we need your help and cooperation in finding those errors. Please stop by and check out the Boards soon.

## - Weekly Reflection -

#### THE COSTS OF DISCIPLESHIP

Today's responsorial psalm, Psalm 40, is more familiar to us with the refrain "Here am I, Lord." This "Here am I" is Jeremiah's great prophetic response to God's call. But today's story of Jeremiah and the refrain "Lord, come to my aid!" remind us that there are always two sides to following the call of God. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews knew this, too. He reminded his readers that even weighted down with burdens and sins, we can still persevere by keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, who himself knew the shame and pain of the cross, but saw beyond it to the joy of sitting at the right of the throne of God. Jesus himself gave the disciples a "sneak preview" of a baptism that would not be as wondrous as the one in the Jordan that inaugurated his ministry, but would be one of fire and anguish. Today's words from scripture may not be terribly soothing, but in their honesty and strength we can acknowledge the difficulties of daily discipleship, and take comfort in the assurance of our own salvation in Christ.
