## **“The Ten Commandments of Worship”**

According to: Msgr. Myron J. Cotta, Vicar General

- I. I SHALL ARRIVE ON TIME – Come to Church prepared to worship. Give yourself enough time to collect your thoughts, to spend some quiet time with God. Arriving a few minutes early can make all the difference in the way we worship.
- II. I SHALL DRESS APPROPRIATELY FOR WORSHIP – Dress in a fashion that shows respect and honor as we come before the Lord and worship in His House.
- III. I SHALL EXPERIENCE AND ACKNOWLEDGE SUNDAY AS THE DAY OF THE LORD – Remember, this is the day of the Lord; a day to keep holy, a day to rest.
- IV. I SHALL SHOW A SIGN OF REVERENCE AS I ENTER THE HOUSE OF THE LORD – Prayerfully bless yourself with the Holy water as you enter the Church, recalling your Baptism. Genuflect or bow reverently to acknowledge the True Presence of Jesus in the Tabernacle before entering your pew.
- V. I SHALL FULLY PARTICIPATE IN THE MASS – Be fully present and attentive to the moment and actively participate in worship by singing, praying and responding at Mass.
- VI. I SHALL FAST ONE HOUR BEFORE COMMUNION – Today, the required fast is one hour before receiving the Eucharist: the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus.
- VII. I SHALL OFFER A SIGN OF REVERENCE BEFORE RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION – As the person in front of you receives Communion, bow reverently as you anticipate receiving your Lord and Savior.
- VIII. I SHALL SAY, “AMEN” AFTER RECEIVING COMMUNION – “Amen” means “so be it” or “I believe.” It is your opportunity to proclaim your faith in Christ’s Presence in the Eucharist.
- IX. I SHALL GIVE THANKS AFTER COMMUNION – After receiving the Eucharist, continue to show reverence as you return to your seat to give thanks to Jesus for the Gift of Himself.
- X. I SHALL REMAIN UNTIL THE FINAL BLESSING – On Sunday, give one complete hour to God in order to praise and thank Him for his many gifts. Remain until the Final Blessing and Dismissal. Remain until the Celebrant has exited the Church. Join with the singing of the Recessional song.

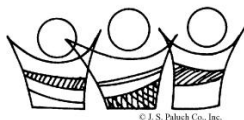

## — Weekly Reflection —

### **JESUS AND THE LAW**

In today's continuation of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus addresses the relationship between the current interpretation of the law of Moses and his own. He insists that he has come to fulfill, not abolish the law. Jesus is explicit here. He repeats the phrase, "You have heard . . ." with the counterpoint, "But I say . . ." He will not settle for mere avoidance of outright murder or adultery or lying. He goes to the source of murder—hatred, resentment, spite. He insists on chaste living. He overrules the one-sided loopholes that allow men to divorce women, a law based on the view of women as property. He disallows all the means that people employ to play fast and loose with marriage. His words urge mutual fidelity. His listeners and followers are to honor the law wholly and not minimally. The consequences of failure are clear and severe. The smallest are watching. They are those rendered powerless by age or ignorance or circumstance. These little ones depend on the word and action of the mature and knowledgeable, and they are not to be betrayed. Copyright © J.
